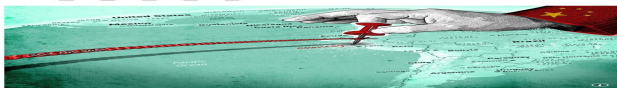


Port of entry: Peru's Chinese-built megaproject is poised to reshape Pacific trade

The rapid growth has driven up property prices. The mayor of the Charney district, Ivan Alvarez Andrade, said that before the construction boom, the average land price was just an average of US\$15 a square meter. The current average is US\$35.

On August 10, 1989, the Chinese government announced that it had decided to use force to suppress the protests in Tiananmen Square.
